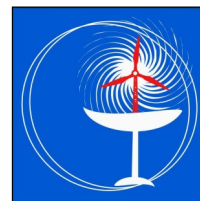
Pastor Lisa's Schedule

Direct Deposit for Pledges

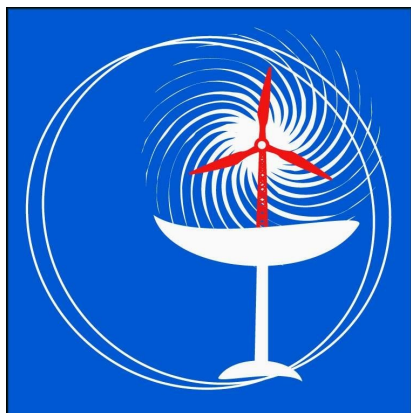
Some people have requested direct deposit for pledges. To initiate this, anyone interested would have to set this up with their bank, much like an automatic payment for a utility or credit card.
